- The college offers 18 different majors and minors that prepare students not only to help sustain the quality and supply of food and fiber people rely on for their most basic needs, but also to address issues such as natural resources conservation, environmental protection, local and global economic development, and ultimately, improvements in the health, quality of life, and well-being of humankind and the planet.
- The college's academic programs have an exceptional record of preparing students to meet these challenges, as well as entrance to graduate school, veterinary medicine, law, medical, and other professional schools. In addition, its graduates are in high demand for jobs in agribusiness, natural resource management, business, research, academia, and government.
- Seniors majoring in horticulture have received an average of three to five solid, career-track job offers by the time they graduate, and poultry science graduates an average of three to four offers. Food science graduates have one to two offers.
- For the 2013-14 academic year, almost 26% of undergraduates in the College of Agriculture received at least one scholarship through the college's strong scholarship program. The college awarded 433 individual scholarships totaling more than \$683,000 to 263 students.
- Students in the college receive support from faculty advisors in their areas of study. The College of Agriculture is the only recipient on campus of the Auburn University Student Government Association's Outstanding Faculty Advisement Award.
- The college's School of Fisheries, Aquaculture, and Aquatic Sciences is ranked as first in the world because of its current and past work in more than 100 countries and its 1,400-acre research and teaching facility near the Auburn campus dedicated to fresh and saltwater research.
- The college offers global experiences through a variety of study abroad programs and international travel opportunities. Past destinations have included China, England, Ecuador, Italy, Spain, and the Netherlands.
- Biosystems engineering undergraduate enrollment has doubled in the past five years, and the proportion of female students has grown steadily to its current 40% of undergraduate enrollment. The program emphasizes engineering applications in biological systems and the environment.
- The college has 23 student organizations that help their members develop leadership skills, network with alumni and faculty, and participate in skill training.
- Internships with prestigious entities such as Disney World, Augusta National, Monsanto, Biltmore Estate, Tyson Foods, Fenway Park, and Nestlé give students invaluable real-world experience in their chosen fields.
