- *U.S. News & World Report* ranked Harbert College's online graduate programs 12th nationally. The publication also placed the college's MBA program second nationally on its list of "MBAs with the Most Financial Value at Graduation."
- The college launched a Business Analytics program in Fall 2013 to meet growing industry needs for "Big Data" experts. Students who graduate from the program will be able to analyze information and use the findings to guide organizational decision-making.
- The college reintroduced itself as Harbert College in June 2013 after receiving a \$40 million commitment from 1982 alumnus Raymond J. Harbert – the largest gift in Auburn University history. His gift enabled the college to create a Ph.D. program in finance and will also lead to other changes, including the creation of new research centers devoted to investments and supply chain management.
- Harbert College students accounted for 30% of all Auburn University students studying abroad in 2013. Their travels took them to Brazil, China, the Czech Republic, France, Germany, Great Britain, Hungary, Ireland, Japan, Poland, Spain, and South Korea for class trips and internships.
- The college and the School of Accountancy are accredited at the undergraduate and graduate levels by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB International). Less than 5% of the world's 13,000 business programs have earned AACSB Accreditation. AACSB-accredited schools produce graduates who are highly skilled and more desirable to employers than other non-accredited schools.
- CPA Exam pass rates of Auburn's Master of Accountancy (MAc) graduates continue to be among the top in the country. Pass rate, on the four parts of the CPA exam, range from 88% to 95%.
- The TIGER (Trading, Investing, & Global Economic Research) Lab is a state-of-the-art investment center in Lowder Hall where students get hands-on experience in securities analysis and decision-making in real and simulated environments.
- The Office of Professional and Career Development was established in 2010 to prepare business students for successfully entering and excelling in the workplace. The office's location in Lowder Hall centralizes recruiting, career education, and professional development.
