- The Harrison School of Pharmacy (HSOP) has been a part of Auburn University since 1885, with a program built on the value of caring as it educates tomorrow's pharmacists.
- Personal character, confidence, and competence are traits of graduates entering practice to assume leadership positions in their communities.
- Student pharmacists continuously care for patients, beginning with their first semester when they are placed on teams with second-year and third-year students and two faculty members to provide basic pharmaceutical care to community-based patients.
- HSOP annually admits 149 students who have the following profile: average GPA-3.4; average PCAT composite percentile-64%; female-70%, previous BS or higher degree-70%; Auburn University students-50%; out-of-state residents-25% and in-state residents-75%.
- The school operates the Employee and Student Health Center Pharmacies and the Pharmaceutical Care Clinic, which offers wellness and medication management programs to improve health care outcomes and decrease costs.
- While boasting a 96% graduation rate, HSOP graduates also demonstrate a 97% pass rate on their first attempt for the national license exam.
- HSOP has an education and clinic wing, which features an active pharmaceutical care clinic and retail pharmacy, team rooms, and lecture space equipped with the latest technology and electronic media resources.
- HSOP operates a satellite campus in Mobile, AL, on the campus of the University of South Alabama, allowing for collaboration with students in other health professions and with facilities that replicate those at Auburn. Each class has a total of 24 students.
- HSOP student pharmacists have opportunities to complete elective practice experiences in a variety of international settings.
