Carnegie Hall, home to the popular **PSYCHOLOGY AND NEUROSCIENCE PROGRAMS**, was renovated in its 100th year to include laboratory spaces for social, cognitive, clinical, developmental and physiological psychology experiments, including research on autism, drug addiction, stress, moral behavior, learning and memory, and emotion.

In addition, the facility includes equipment to measure sleep and electrical activity in the human brain, as well as spaces for research on neurodegenerative disease and for sensation and perception from both cellular and behavioral perspectives.
